#### **REDEEMER CHURCH NEWS**

Redeemer Church normally worships on Saturday or Sunday - that depends on the day of mission trip. There were 19 members as of August 2023, but in September 2023 three new members (parents and son) joined us from Dorng Antak village, Kampong Thom.

Mr. Noun and Mrs. San are orphans. They have 2 children Ny Samphors—11 years old girl—grade 5 and Ny Samphorn— 4 years old boy. In Noun's family, his wife and daughter were the first ones opened their heart to Jesus in 2018. After she was baptized, she were expecting a baby which is her son (Ny Samphorn). Last year they dug their mother's tomb to collect all bones to celebrate a ceremony and keep the bones in her house. From that day, Mrs. San started falling sick. She went to private hospitals and a witch doctor's house to stay and treat her sickness. They spent all their money up and started borrowing from outsiders to do that because they expected to be healed. However, her sickness became worse and worse.

We heard about her treatment at witch doctor's house we were discouraged and angry as she is a believer she should call to God and pray or tell us about her issue to pray for her. However, we forgave her because the truth was she was tempted to turn back from God—most gossips in the village said that she has been sick because she believes in Jesus.

We prayed for her and asked her to come and stay at Cambodian Harvest Dried Fruit. She agreed. She and her husband came to stay with us for a month. We supported their living and treatment costs. She got better, the poisonous chemical in her blood was reduced and she asked to return home. About 6 months back home at the village, she recovered her sickness. At this time she asked to stay and work as a Cambodian Harvest staff to support her living and treatment costs. We accepted her and her family (husband and son). They left their daughter at the village due to her study. San's health is steadily improving.

Actually, this house our church used for worship once, but they lost it to the microfinance company to repay their \$6000 debt. During the month, they have been staying and working with us, Noun's heart opened to accept God in his life and he was baptized in Cambodian Harvest's fish pond on October 7, 2023. Noun is a talented and independent man, able to support his family. His self-confident personality made him ignore God. However, God chose him and God has a way to let his glorified love penetrate Noun's heart. "Our God is Great". We are amazed with God's power to change lives. Within God's love, they work happily at Cambodian Harvest and they are worthy of their monthly salary of \$70.00. We are happy to be a big family of God with three members added to Cambodian Harvest Dried Fruit. However, we strongly pray to our God to supply us as our monthly salary. We regularly keep praying for this family not to be tempted and firmly stay with our God in all circumstances.
